Walleye Road Vacate: Supervisor Fiedler explained that a petition has been filed with the town board about a desire to vacate Walleye Road. If this were to be done the property, the township owns down by the river would be land locked. 97 residents were present, sent emails, phone calls or letters stating the desire not to close this landing access onto the Mississippi River. There were 16 petitioners in favor of vacating Walleye Road.

Craig Sexton who lives next to the township's property was asked by T. Pogatchnik if he would be willing to sell his property so there would be more room for the boat access. Mr. Sexton said he would not be against it.
