2. New Business:
  - A. Consider and recommend updated and clarifications to provisions of the Brockway Township Road Standards and Access Ordinance. The Board Members reviewed the changes and this will be added to the November 2018 Regular Town Meeting.
  - B. Review Townships MS4. It was discussed to change to the Ordinance to an acre or more. This will be added to the November 2018 Regular Meeting.
  - C. Consider and recommend updated to the Town Fee Ordinance. Changes were discussed and this will be added to the November 2018 Regular Meeting.
  - D. Review Draft of Shared Road Maintenance Agreement with St Wendel Township. It was decided to divide the road equally. Except for snowplowing; St. Wendel will do section East of County Road 1 and Brockway does East of 115<sup>th</sup>. A draft of the agreement will be sent to St. Wendel for their review.
  
3. Old Business: Lyle Schefers was present to discuss a survey discrepancy. Zoning Administrator Sandal will work with Mr. Schefers outside the meeting.
  
4. *A motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:24 p.m. by Commissioner Fiedler which was seconded by Commissioner Douvier; all in favor, motion carried.*
