MEETING MINUTES

June 17, 2024

APPROVED

1. **Call to Order:**

- On the 17th of June 2024, the Regular meeting was called to order at 7:30. The Pledge was recited. All Supervisors present. PC Sandal was absent.
- Motion made by Fiedler to approve the agenda with additions; seconded Douvier approved.

Motion made by Fiedler to approve the May minutes, seconded Douvier, approved.

4. **Treasurer's Report:**

- A. Motion made by Fiedler to approve the May report on accounts, seconded Pogatchnik, approved.
- B. Motion made by Fiedler to approve Claims No #: 23060-23073, seconded Pogatchnik, approved.

5. **Public Input:**

Deputy Steve Noetzel was present and stated he did not really have anything. He checked out 421st and 95th Av he agreed with having the chevrons. Also has been down at Smart's Ferry and has found no problems. Fiedler stated a complaint of roofing nails on 125th S of 131 were causing a lot of flat tires. Deputy will check into it further.

6. **Old Business:**

- A. **Roads:** Pogatchnik advised there is poison ivy in the ROW in Rockline Addition was inquiring if he could get someone out to spray the weed. Motion made by Fiedler to allow the poison ivy to be sprayed, seconded Douvier, approved. Fiedler inquired of when Sir Lines A lot was going to start stripping, Clerk will make a call. Fiedler also asked if the new roads done should be stripped and it was agreed this should be done. Douvier stated the culvert on 115th needs to be done, but it has been wet, and Burski has not been able to do it yet.
- B. **Road map for Brockway Township:** Fiedler has contacted Sambatek, and they can do a basic map for \$2,955 or more detailed at \$4,525. Supervisors agreed a basic map would be acceptable, Douvier asked if they would coordinate with the county as well on the roads, Fiedler stated they would.

7. **New Business:**

Speed limit / 427th: Pogatchnik was contacted by a resident wishing to have the speed put down lower as this is not a thru road. After much discussion on the speed Supervisors all agreed to put it down to 30 mph, signs will be ordered and installed by Jon Anderson of ID Solutions.

Opole Gambling permit: Motion made by Fiedler to approve an off-sale gambling permit for the village of Opole for their fundraiser, seconded Pogatchnik.

John Smoley: John gave a report on what he has been doing and asked if they had work for him to call and he would get it done. Supervisors were agreeable to this.

Susan Goodew: Treasurer Goodew handed out a detailed page indicating where all the money came from for the CD. It showed what was left in each fund. She believes we should be okay, but if needed we can take the CD out early, we would just lose six months of interest. Treasurer asked if it was okay to move money from the Interest Fund to zero out the Pine Point account and FEMA account. Motion made by Fiedler to allow her to do this, seconded by Douvier, approved.

10721 450th St: Douvier received a call from the resident at this address complaining about sink holes in his yard. Upon further looking it was discovered that there is a culvert running parallel to the road which is breaking up and causing the sink holes. Discussion between the board concluded that the best thing would be to have Burski dump black dirt in this area and see if this takes care of the problem.

Mail was looked over and discussion was brought up about Pesta's lot split, we will wait to see what comes from them working with Sam Deleo.
