5. **Old Business:**

- A. **Roads:** Pogatchnik stated a resident informed him of the culvert on 65th Avenue being damaged, Pogatchnik will go out and look to see how severe. Douvier informed that a resident was concerned about a manhole cover on Loganberry Court. Discussion was whether it is a private or township since it is connected to the septic system in Mullberry Meadows. Fiedler will be checking into this further. Douvier also stated that 115th Avenue culvert was replaced and road patched. Pogatchnik asked about when the signs were to be put up, Clerk will check again with John Anderson.
- B. **Road map:** Fiedler informed that he has the process started for getting a new township road map and will be working with Mike Nielsen.
- C. **Road striping 95th & 440th St:** Fiedler had a proposal for striping 95th and 440th St. It was soon discovered that it should have been for 438th and 85th Avenue, plus 105th from River Street to CR 17. Fiedler will get a new proposal.
- D. **Weeds:** Clerk was tasked with informing Knife River of weeds at the Skroch pit. She called and spoke with Knife River and they stated they would get this done.
- E. **Prairie Grass Lane:** Fiedler stated the plat map had been sent to Ruppe to look over and as of today we have not heard back from him. Fiedler will follow up on.
- F. **Township meeting rules:** Fiedler handed out a copy of rules for the board to look over and we will address at the next meeting.
- G. **Engineer:** Fiedler asked if we had an Engineer if we needed something done. Board members agreed that it would be Mike Nielsen.

- H. **Nuisance complaint deadline:** Clerk stated the deadline for this complaint to be taken care of was August 1. Fiedler drove up there tonight and found that some improvement had been made, but there were still more items around. Another visit to the site might be needed.
- I. **Emergency signs for residents:** Fiedler was wondering about the 911 signs if this is something we should require the residents to have or not. Board members agreed that it should be up to the residents. With the use of cell phones and GPS easy to find a resident without a 911 sign.
